In-Person Meeting Attendance COVID-19 Policy

EMA meetings participants must understand that neither EMA nor the meeting facility can prevent participants from being exposed to, contracting or spreading COVID-19. As such, it is important that participants acknowledge and agree that by attending an EMA meeting in-person they will:

- Follow all applicable health and safety guidelines, policies, and mandates, including those implemented or recommended by EMA or the meeting facility (regardless of whether federal, state or local laws dictate less stringent requirements). That may include wearing a face mask and maintaining appropriate social distance.
- Monitor their own health status and not attend the meeting in-person if they (i) are not feeling well or are experiencing any of the symptoms associated with COVID (e.g., fever or chills, headache, cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, diarrhea, sore throat, congestion or nausea or vomiting); (ii) have been in close contact with someone with COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to the meeting; (iii) have had a positive COVID-19 test in the 10 days prior to the meeting (or are awaiting results of a COVID-19 test); or (iv) have been told by a public health or medical professional to self-monitor, self-isolate, or quarantine.
- Participate at their own risk and understand that in-person participation includes possible exposure to and illness from COVID-19 and includes the potential risk of serious illness or death.
